The San Diego Downtown Lions Club, through its Welfare Foundation, has scholarship assistance available to students graduating from eight area high schools so that they may pursue higher education in an undergraduate college or vocational school of their choice. Scholarships of \$1,500.00 will be awarded to each student selected.

Applicants must be U.S. citizen (or legal residents) and residents of the U.S.

Legal residents must submit a copy of their alien registration ID card and write their registration number on the application form in the designated area. Graduating seniors will be selected **only from Hoover, Garfield, Kearny, Twain, Lincoln and San Diego High School, Monarch and Gompers** as this scholarship is intended to assist graduating seniors from the geographical operating area of the San Diego Downtown Lions Club. **Applications submitted from students of other schools will not be considered.**

We are seeking individuals who have demonstrated a desire to serve their communities and will continue to foster a spirit of community service. For this reason, scholarships will be awarded based on scholarship, financial need and demonstrated community service.

Applicants should fully complete the application form, the financial data form, and provide transcripts from their high school.

Please insure that your personal identifying information (e.g. name, address, phone or cell phone and e-mail address) is legible.

All applicants should submit a typed essay explaining why they deserve this scholarship. The essay should include your activities in or out of school that are beneficial to others. This may include but are not limited to help to family members, music/performing arts, sports, civic groups, church, etc.

Application and all completed materials **must be received** in the Lions Club office by 4 pm on Thursday March 19, 2020.

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Failure to provide any of these items as described may disqualify your entry. The scholarships will be awarded based on scholarship merit, financial need, and demonstration of community service.
