### **2020 Exam Registration Form**

As college costs grow each year, the prospect of continuing education becomes less and less of a reality for many high school students. By making it through an AP course and scoring successfully on the related AP Exam, you can save on college expenses. Currently more than 90 percent of colleges and universities across the country offer college credit for qualifying AP Exam scores. These credits can potentially save students and their families thousands of dollars in college tuition, fees and textbook costs, which can transform what once seemed unaffordable into something within reach.

Please discuss the advanced placement (AP) program with your family and review the benefits of taking an AP exam, then complete the following registration form. **In addition to completing this form, students also need to register for each of their AP courses online using course codes provided by teachers. See AP Class Online Enrollment below.**

#### **Regular AP Exam Cost**

The 2020 AP exam fee for each test ordered is \$94.00.

#### **AP Exam Cost with a Qualified Fee Waiver**

The 2020 AP exam fee for qualified fee reduction families will be \$5.00 for each test ordered.

#### **Fee Reduction Option**

Educational Testing Service has a policy whereby students who are approved for fee reductions, based on family income, pay a lower price (\$5.00 per exam) instead of the regular \$94.00 fee. Fee reductions should be requested **only** for those students whose financial need is clear. In addition, there is no limit to the number of AP exams income-eligible students can take.

#### **AP Class Online Enrollment (Step 1 & 2)**

Students register for their AP class no later than October 1st. Students need to sign in to [My AP](#) using their College Board account to enroll in each class section using the unique join code provided by the teacher of each AP class they're taking. #### **AP Registration Form & Payment Due Date: 3:00 p.m. on November 7<sup>th</sup>, 2019**

The AP Registration Form & payment must be completed and turned in to the San Diego High Finance Office by the November 7<sup>th</sup> due date. **Make checks payable to: SDHS with the students name on the memo line.**

#### **Late Fees**

An additional \$40.00 will be charged per exam if student registers between November 16<sup>th</sup>, 2019 and March 13<sup>th</sup>, 2020. **No AP exams will be ordered after March 13<sup>th</sup>, 2020.**

#### **Unused/Canceled Exam Fees:**

A \$40 per exam fee will be charged for:

- Exams canceled after November 15<sup>th</sup> and by March 13<sup>th</sup> (11:59 p.m. ET).
- Exams that aren't taken.

**Step 1:** Sign Into myapp.collegeboard.org using your College Board student account login. Create an account if you do not have an account set up yet.

**Step 2:** Enroll in Each of Your AP Class Sections using course code provided by teacher.

**Step 3:** Complete Student and Family Information on form (Page 2)

**Step 4:** Complete Statement of Eligibility 2019/2020 to determine if you qualify for fee waivers. (Page 3)

**Step 5:** Choose which AP exam(s) you will be taking. (Page 4)

**Step 6:** Determine the amount due for your AP exam(s). (Page 5)

## AP Exams 101

Each of the 38 AP exams has its own unique requirements; however, almost all of the exams have several things in common:

- Most exams are two to three hours long. Be prepared to tackle a challenging exam with limited breaks. Eat a good breakfast and, if you are taking more than one exam on the same day, make sure you have lunch and snacks to keep you going.
- The first part of the exam usually consists of multiple-choice questions. You will choose one of four or five answer choices for each question and use a pencil to bubble in your choice on your AP answer sheet. Your total exam score on the multiple-choice section is based only on the number of questions answered correctly. You won't receive or lose points for incorrect answers or unanswered questions.
- The second part of the exam usually consists of free-response questions that require you to generate your own responses. Depending on the exam, your responses could be in the form of an essay, a solution to a problem, or a spoken response. In most cases, you'll be writing your response in pen in the free-response exam booklet.
- If you are taking an AP Studio Art class (Drawing or 2-D design), you will not take a test. Instead you will be submitting a digital portfolio of 24 pieces. In addition, you will be submitting a 5-piece quality portfolio of actual pieces that will be mailed to AP Central. These pieces will be mailed back to your home address during the summer.
- Your AP teacher will go over the exam format with you in class.
