UP TO TWO YEARS OF FREE TUITION

The San Diego Promise is a two-year completion program designed to ensure students complete their educational goal whether it be to earn a certificate of completion and enter the workforce, complete an associate degree, or transfer to a university.

#### PROGRAM BENEFITS

- Individualized support to help you complete your education goals
- Assigned Peer Mentor/Success Coach
- Individualized counseling and guidance support
- Priority consideration for transfer to SDSU

\*Students who meet program requirements in their first year may be eligible for free tuition in their second year

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

- Must be a California resident for tuition purposes or AB 540 eligible Visit <a href="https://www.sdccd.edu/students/fees.aspx">https://www.sdccd.edu/students/fees.aspx</a> for more information on AB 540 eligibility
- Must be a class of 2019 high school graduate
- Must complete a 2019-2020 FAFSA or Dream Act application

#### PROGRAM REOUIREMENTS

- Attend an on-campus Promise orientation
- Sign a Promise contract
- Enroll in at least 12 units by September 3, 2019
- Meet with a counselor each semester
- Complete a Personal Growth course in the first year
- Complete a comprehensive education plan by the end of the first year
- Maintain a 2.0 or higher grade point average
