Goals, Outcomes/Objectives:

What do we want to accomplish?

We believe goals are the desired outcome of the program, over time.

How are we going to achieve our goals?

We believe the objectives are specific and measureable targets for accomplishing a goal. They mark interim steps towards achieving the mission and goals. The objectives are measurable, time-based statements of intent, linked directly to the goals. They emphasize the results of actions at the end of a specific time.

1. **Academic Planning Goal:** By June 2018, class of 2021 will decrease D/F rates of one or more from Semester 1 to semester 2 by 10%.

Priority Area: Navigate the High School Experience.

Essential #1: Decrease the fail rate and increase the attendance rate.

2. **Social/Emotional Guidance Goal:** By June 2018, class of 2021 students will increase their meaningful participation and improve their school connectedness by 5%.

Priority Area: Value Enrichment & Extracurricular Engagement.

Essential #1: Create meaningful participation and improve school connectedness.

Data Source: Student survey, need baseline and post survey.

Action:

- 9th grade passport
- Visit a club
- Knowing resources on campus
- Parents involved



3. **College & Career Readiness Goal:**

By June 2018, 100% of class of 2021 will create a 4-year high school plan.

Priority Area: Navigate the High School Experience.

Essential #1: Align the University of California U-C *a-g* and SDUSD high school graduation requirements with the 4-year plan.

Data Source: Completed high school plan.

Action:

- Core curriculum lessons on UC a-g and HS graduation requirements.
- Pre- and post tests
