COLLEGE & CAREER ACCESS PATHWAYS (CCAP)

- CCAP enrollment allows high school students to enroll in college courses and receive college credit in addition to high school credit towards graduation.
- 10 college courses may count towards graduation credit. It is recommended students consider 2 CCAP courses in 10th grade, 4 courses in 11th grade and 4 courses in 12th grade.
- Course enrollment and textbooks are FREE for SDUSD students enrolled in a CCAP course.

COLLEGE & CAREER ACCESS PATHWAYS (CCAP)

- CCAP program allows students to take a college course taught at their high school as part of their regular school day, by college professors.
- GOAL: Develop seamless pathways from high school to community college for career technical education, preparation for transfer, improving high school graduation rates and helping high school pupils achieve college and career readiness.
