2020/2021 SAT/ACT: Fee Waiver Eligibility Form

A student must be either enrolled in or eligible to participate in the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) to get a fee waiver. Although ALL San Diego High students receive free lunch service, not ALL students will automatically receive fee waivers. San Diego High participates in federal programs as a Community Eligibility School, which means students can't rely only on participation in the NSLP, students must use individual family criteria to determine student fee waiver eligibility.

To determine student eligibility:

- The student's annual family income falls within the Income Eligibility Guidelines set by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Food and Nutrition Service.
- The student is enrolled in a federal, state, or local program that aids students from low-income families (e.g., TRIO programs like Upward Bound).
- The student's family receives public assistance.
- Student's family qualifies for Medical.
- The student lives in federally subsidized public housing or a foster home, or is homeless.
- The student is a ward of the state or an orphan.
