

Applicant Information Page

You will need to save once you complete the Applicant Information Form and upload this document with your entire application submission.



- 1. Letter of Recommendation (teacher, supervisor, advisor) about your current academic status, academic and extracurricular achievements, personal qualities, leadership, commitment, motivation, and potential for success.
- 2. Unofficial Transcript. Counselors will take care of uploading your Unofficial Transcript required for the application.
- 3. A <u>typed</u> personal statement describing your academic plans, career goals, and community contributions.
- 4. Extracurricular activities, including volunteer work, and part-time employment. Please include this section on a separate piece of paper and attach to your application. Be sure to type your responses.

- Scholarship Amount: \$1,500
- Open to students in all SDHS small schools.
- Must be a senior planning to enroll in an accredited four-year college or university.
- Have a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Demonstrate involvement in extracurricular activities.
- Demonstrate financial need.

Bravo Zulu Scholarship

Sponsored by the Midway Foundation

- Scholarship Amount: \$2,000
- Open to students in all SDHS small schools.
- Must be a senior at SDHS planning to continue their education at a trade school, two year or four year university.
- This scholarship is for seniors who have contributed to SDHS and/or the greater community.
- From masons to marketers, from equipment operators, the Midway staff and volunteers support the wealth of career opportunities in the trades and professions practiced aboard an aircraft carrier.



- Scholarship Amount: <u>5 at \$1,000 and 2 at \$2,500</u>
- Open to students in all SDHS small schools.
- Be a graduating senior planning to attend college, trade school, or a four year university.
- Have a 3.0 GPA or higher.
- Demonstrate financial need.
- Prefer candidates who have aspirations toward a teaching career.

Class of 1960 Alumni Scholarship Award

- Scholarship Amount: \$500
- Open to students in all SDHS small schools.
- Must be a senior at SDHS planning to enroll in a community college.
- Must have a GPA of 3.5 or higher in English, and an overall GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Submit a letter of recommendation from an English teacher.

Karen deLaurier IB Scholarship

- Scholarship Amount: \$1,000
- Must be a senior attending the School of International Studies.
- Must be an IB Diploma Candidate.
- Must be planning to attend a four year college or university.
- Have a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Show evidence of community service.



Jose Gonzales Athletic Scholarship

- Scholarship Amount: \$300
- Open to students in all SDHS small schools.
- Must be a senior varsity letter athlete.
- Must have a recommendation letter from the team coach.
- Must be a graduating senior planning to attend community college or a four year university.



Carrilou Ward Hurlbut Music Award

Class of 1949

- Scholarship Amount: \$500
- Open to students in all SDHS small schools.
- Must be a senior attending SDHS studying orchestra, band, IB music, or AP music theory.
- Have a GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- Submit a written recommendation from the music teacher.

Steve McIntire Memorial Scholarship

- Scholarship Amount: \$1,500
- Open to students in all SDHS small schools.
- Must be a senior planning to enroll in an accredited four year college or university.
- Must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Demonstrate involvement in extracurricular activities.
- Demonstrate financial need.





Murphy Family Scholarships Stanley Wanell Murphy Scholarship

- Scholarship Amount: \$1,000
- Must be a senior attending the School of International Studies.
- Be a graduating senior planning to attend community college, trade school, or a four-year university.
- Have a 3.0 or higher GPA.
- Demonstrate involvement in extracurricular activities.
- Plans to pursue a career in teaching.
- The student must explain in their personal statement how they fulfilled this requirement.



Murphy Family Scholarships Hura Doc Murphy Memorial Scholarship

- Scholarship Amount: \$1,000
- Open to students in all SDHS small schools.
- Be a graduating senior planning to attend community college, trade school, or a four-year university.
- Have a 3.0 or higher GPA.
- Must have overcome hardships, handicaps, or other obstacles in their personal life to achieve academic success at SDHS.
- The student must explain in their personal statement how they meet this requirement.





Murphy Family Scholarships Irene Murphy Memorial Scholarship

- Scholarship Amount: \$1,000
- Open to students in all SDHS small schools.
- Be a graduating senior planning to attend community college, trade school, or a four-year university.
- Have a 3.0 or higher GPA.
- Must demonstrate evidence of successful participation in school, community, and/or international service.
- The student must explain in their personal statement how they have fulfilled this requirement.

Burr C. Passenheim Science/Math Award

- Scholarship Amount: \$2,500
- Must be a senior attending the School of International Studies or the School of Science & Technology.
- Must be planning to continue their education at a four-year college or university.
- Must be planning to major in math, physics, chemistry, engineering, or computer science.
- Demonstrate excellence in advanced courses in science and/or math.
- Have a GPA of 3.5 or higher.



Irma Risty Scholarship

- Scholarship Amount: \$2,500
- Must be a senior attending the School of International Studies or the School of Science & Technology.
- Must be planning to continue their education at a four-year college or university.
- Must be planning to pursue a major in mathematics or engineering.
- Participation in extracurricular mathematics activities such as math competitions or robotics.
- Have a GPA of 3.5 or higher, with demonstrated excellence in mathematics.
- Submit a written recommendation from a member of the schools' mathematics faculty.
- Demonstrate financial need.

San Diego Woman's Club (SDWC) Scholarships In Memory of Mrs. Mildred Wood

Mildred Wood was a member of the San Diego Woman's Club from 1993 until her passing in November 2020, one week short of her 102nd birthday. Mildred had a career as a teacher and guidance counselor.

- Scholarship Amount: \$2,500
- Open to students in all SDHS small schools.
- This scholarship is for graduating female student planning to attend a two year or four year college or university.
- Must have contributed to SDHS and/or the greater community.
- Must be planning to pursue a career in education or school counseling.
- Must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- The awardee must contact the San Diego Woman's Club at least twice yearly to report her progress.
- This is a renewable scholarship of the awardee maintains a GPA of 3.0 or higher.

San Diego Woman's Club (SDWC) Scholarships In Honor of Mrs. Margaret Hawkinson (age 104)

Margaret has been a faithful member of the San Diego Woman's Club since 1986. She had a career as a Speech Pathologist.

- Scholarship Amount: \$2,500
- Open to students in all SDHS small schools.
- This scholarship is for graduating female student planning to attend a two year or four year college or university.
- Must have contributed to SDHS and/or the greater community.
- Must be planning to pursue a career in speech pathology or other therapy related areas.
- Must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- The awardee must contact the San Diego Woman's Club at least twice yearly to report her progress.
- This is a renewable scholarship of the awardee maintains a GPA of 3.0 or higher.

SDHS Foundation Scholarship Award

- Scholarship Amount: \$1,000
- Open to students in all SDHS small schools.
- Must be a graduating senior planning to attend a two-year or four-year college or university.
- Must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Show evidence of community service.
- Show interest in technology or a career program.




L.N. Temko Scholarship Award

- Show evidence of community service in the **Sherman Elementary area**.
- Have a GPA of 2.5 or higher.



Rose M. Wirtz Memorial Scholarship

- Scholarship Amount: \$2,500
- Must be a graduating senior in the School of Business & Leadership.
- Have a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Planning to pursue a degree in the business field.



Stout Family Scholar/Athlete Scholarship

- Scholarship Amount: \$500
- Open to students in all SDHS small schools.
- Be a graduating senior.
- Have a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Have lettered in at least one sport.
- Submit a letter of recommendation from a coach.
